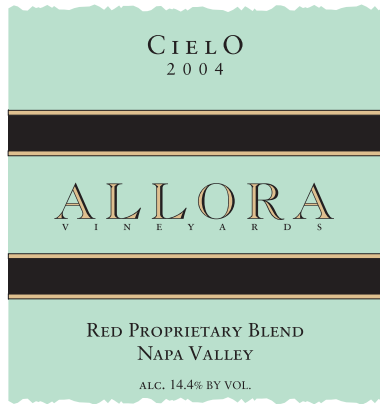

TASTING NOTES:

BOUQUET: Ripe Raspberry, Cherry, Toasted Nut and Espresso

COLOR: Dark, Intense Red-Purple tones

BODY: Complex, Rich, and Spicy

FINISH: Round, Full, and Lingering

AGING: Drinkable now, ages beautifully

HARVEST AND BLENDING NOTES:

HARVEST TIME: Late September

BRIX: 26.5

TOTAL ACIDITY: .60

PH LEVEL: 3.65

BLEND: Merlot (50%), Cab. Sauv. (25%), Sangiovese (20%), Barbera (5%)

FRUIT SOURCE: Allora Vineyards Estate, St. Helena and Stag's Leap District

“Cielo” is our Tuscan Blend. It is an elegant combination of 50% St. Helena Estate Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Stag’s Leap Sangiovese, and 5% Napa Valley Barbera. “Cielo” (ch-ell-o) is smooth and sophisticated with a hint of spiciness. This wine has an outstanding, drinkable quality. “Cielo” means “sky” or “heaven.” “Cielo” is a blend that will only be made in exceptional vintages. The “Cielo” blend will change in order to use the best fruit available. In 2004 we chose to make “Cielo” to utilize the outstanding Barbera and Sangiovese.

The dedication that Allora Vineyards has to creating a quality product can clearly be seen in each new blend. Because we continue to use the finest varieties of each vintage, our production is limited. The 2004 “Cielo” was made in small quantities with a total production of 196 cases.

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
