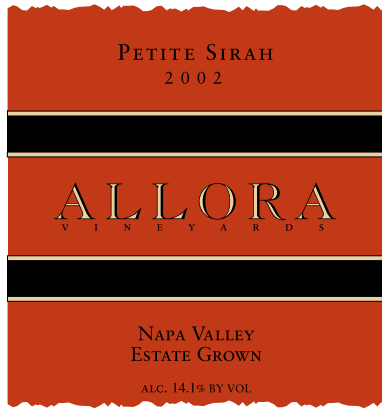

Allora Vineyards proudly welcomes its very first Petite Sirah. This wine is completely estate grown in the St. Helena appellation of the Napa Valley. It is aged for 18 months on Tronçais French oak barrels. In keeping with our strict commitment to quality, we drastically limited the quantity in order to guaranty that this first vintage would be a success. The total production of Petite Sirah is only 85 cases. The bold character in combination with intricate structure and ripe, rich fruit components make this wine truly remarkable.

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
