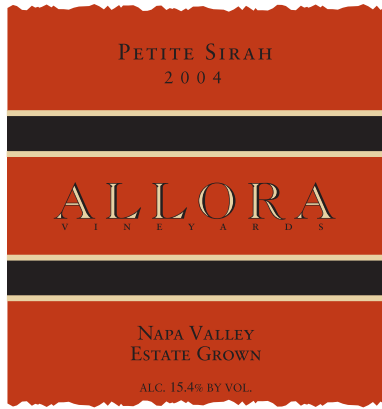

TASTING NOTES:

BOUQUET: Black Currant, Ripe Cherry, Hazelnut and Espresso

COLOR: Dark, Intense, and "Ink-y"

BODY: Concentrated, Complex, and Layered

FINISH: Smooth and Velvety

AGING: Drinkable now, ages beautifully

HARVEST TIME: Late September

BRIX: 27.0

BLEND: Petit Sirah (88%), Cabernet Sauvignon (12%)

FRUIT SOURCE: Allora Vineyards Estate, St. Helena

Allora Vineyards proudly welcomes its Petite Sirah. This wine is completely estate grown in the St. Helena appellation of the Napa Valley. It is aged for 18 months on Troncais French oak barrels. In keeping with our strict commitment to quality, we drastically limited the quantity in order to guaranty that this first vintage would be a success. The total production of Petite Sirah is only 80 cases. The bold character in combination with intricate structure and ripe, rich fruit components make this wine truly remarkable.

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
