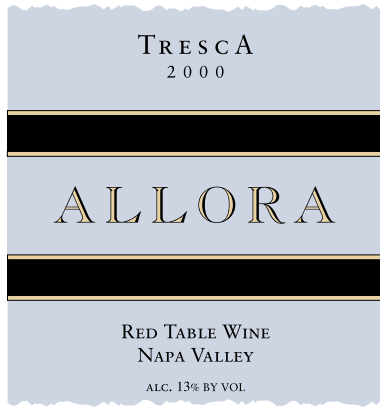

BOUQUET: Black Cherry, Currant, Caramel, Espresso notes

COLOR: Dark, Deep Velvet tones

BODY: Round, Robust, Spicy and Complex

FINISH: Silky, Lush and Lingering

AGING: Drinkable now, ages beautifully

HARVEST AND BLENDING NOTES:

HARVEST TIME: Late October

BRIX: 27.8

TOTAL ACIDITY: .58

PH LEVEL: 3.72

BLEND: Cabernet Sauvignon (80%), Cabernet Franc (10%), Merlot (5%), Malbec (3%), Petit Verdot (2%)

FRUIT SOURCE: Stag's Leap District, Howell Mountain and Yountville

The 2000 Tresca is a Bordeaux Blend, although it could legally be called a varietal Cabernet Sauvignon. Tresca means intrigue in Italian and it certainly is a captivating blend. Another unique characteristic of this blend is that it contains all five of the red Bordeaux varietals. It was aged 24 months on new French Oak barrels.

The year 2000 delighted winemakers and growers as a beautiful start to the new millennium. As in previous vintages, the quality of the Stag's Leap District fruit was astonishing. The gift of exceptional fruit coupled with passion for winemaking makes Tresca a truly well balanced and complex wine. This blend is an excellent demonstration of the dedication Allora Vineyards has to maintaining extraordinary quality. By limiting our production, we have the ability to control what goes into every barrel and every bottle.

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
