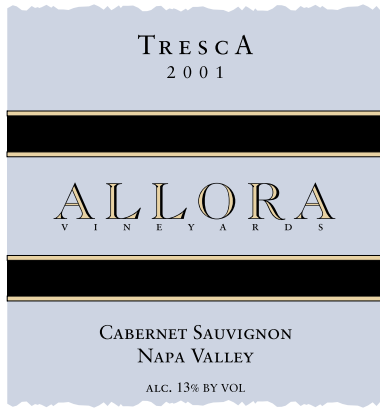

BOUQUET: Black Cherry, Blackberry, Hazelnut, Espresso notes

COLOR: Dark, Deep Velvet tones

BODY: Round, Robust, and Complex

FINISH: Silky, Lush and Lingering

AGING: Drinkable now, ages beautifully

BLEND: Cabernet Sauvignon (78%), Cabernet Franc (12%), Merlot (6%), Malbec (2%), Petit Verdot (2%)

FRUIT SOURCE: Stag's Leap District and Howell Mountain

This is the first vintage that Tresca is officially named a varietal Cabernet Sauvignon. Tresca means intrigue in Italian and it certainly is a captivating blend. Although being a Cabernet Sauvignon, it is also blended with the other four red Bordeaux varietals. It was aged 22 months on new French Oak barrels. The total production was 850 cases.

The 2001 vintage has quickly claimed its respected spot among the outstanding vintages of this decade. As in previous vintages, the quality of the Stag's Leap District fruit was astonishing. The gift of exceptional fruit coupled with passion for winemaking makes Tresca a truly well balanced and complex wine. This Cabernet is an excellent demonstration of the dedication Allora Vineyards has to maintaining extraordinary quality. By limiting our production, we have the ability to control what goes into every barrel and every bottle.

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
