Cielo is a blend of 59% Sangiovese, 37% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 4% Cabernet Franc. The Sangiovese grapes are sourced from the Stag’s Leap District and the Cabernet grapes are estate grown. In 2005, we were able to produce 300 cases. As in the case of many wines blended with Italian varietals, this wine pairs beautifully with tomato sauces, spicy foods or any bold flavors.
